## <u>Tulip cards</u>

## SUPPLIES:

- Tulip flower template
- Coloured card or paper
- Green card or paper
- A4 card
- A5 envelope
- Scissors
- Gluestick

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Make a template using this shape at the top of the instructions.



2. Take the coloured card (not the green pieces) and use the template to draw six flower outlines on them. Cut them out. You need six for each flower.




3. Fold five out of six of the tulips in half. Use the



glue stick to add glue to one of the folded halves of the tulips. Then glue another half to it.



 When you have glued all 5 together, stick them onto the tulip that wasn't folded to create the 3D flower.



- 5. Fold the A4 sheet of card on half and see where you would like to place your flowers. When you have decided where you would like them, glue the back of each tulip, and stick onto the card.
- 6. If you like for another activity, you can stick two halves together and use pipe cleaners to create a bunch of flowers.
- 7. Use the green card to cut out stems and leaves for your tulips, and glue these on as well.



Notes

 If you are using the envelope, then the flowers will need to be folded down in the middle to fit through the post. You can pop a note in telling the person to unflatten them when they get it.
